SIGNIFICANT ACCOMPLISHMENTS

New records in track and field were set in the men's 200- yard dash (Mike Hilliard 22.64 broke a previous record of 32 years), the 800 m relay (Jay Allen, Evest Briggs, Dee Beane, and Mike Hilliard-the previous record set in 1977). Billy Stone broke his own record for the 1600 meter run with a time of 4:23.0. In girls track, Shawna McCullough broke a 27 year- old shot put record with a throw of 39'-5.5"

The Varsity football team recorded a 9-0 regular season record for the fourth time in school history, and qualified for the playoffs for the 10th time in the last 18 years.

The JV Softball team was 23-3.

The JV Boys Basketball team was 15-5.

The Freshman volleyball team was 22-5.

Fruitport hosted MHSAA District tournaments in football, boys' soccer and girls volleyball, as well as bowling regionals. We also hosted GMAA boys' tennis, baseball, girls' golf, and softball. We also hosted Conference Middle School track, and invitationals in tennis, volleyball, and softball.

Football head coach Steve Wilson was named Lakes 8 fall sports coach of the year and Muskegon Chronicle Division 1-4 All area Coach of the Year.

Volleyball Coach Dan Potts was chosen All Area Coach of the Year. He completed his career coaching record at Fruitport with 671 career wins over 16 seasons.

Baseball Coach Paul Masko was named Lakes 8 Baseball Coach of the Year.

The average GPA for student athletes in the class of 2007 was 3.17. The average GPA for seniors who earned 6 or more varsity letters was 3.62.

The Fruitport Athletic Foundation once again committed over \$10,000 in purchases for athletic teams.

Six FCS Coaches completed the first stage for MHSAA Coach Advancement Program certification by completing CAP 1 hosted by FHS in August.

During the 2006-07 school year, three Varsity level coaching positions were filled, and 6 new coaches were hired at the sub-varsity level.

One third of the coaching staff for the 07-08 season are FHS alumni.

Coach Steve Roup is retiring from coaching after 18 seasons with Trojan football.

In the past ten years, female participation rates have increased 22%. Male participation has increased 4.4%.
