Significant Accomplishments

Fruitport won a record **seven Conference Championships**, an all time high in school history, just missing our first ever All -Sport Championship by a slim 10 points.

The Varsity Girls Basketball team recorded its best season in over a decade, and advanced to the District finals for the first time since 1992.

The Boys track team won the schools' first ever Conference track Championship.

Lindsay Bo became the first Fruitport athlete to be named the MHSAA Scholar Athlete Winner: one of 32 winners in nearly 2,000 applicants.

The Girls track team set new records in *five* events.

Senior Holy Anderson (girls track) now has a part in three school records, and was recognized as All State in two events.

Kevin McCauley was a regional champion in Pole Vault.

Randi Perry earned our first Competitive Cheer post- season honor when she was named to the All Regional Team.

The Boys Bowling team finished third in the region and qualified for the state finals for the first time. Junior Taylor Blanchette qualified for the individual finals in finishing in the top ten at Regionals.

Fruitport hosted championships in Confernce Volleyball, Boys and Girls Tennis, GMAA Bowling, Regional Bowling, Class A State Finals Bowling, and Girls District Soccer.

The Boys Soccer team earned the MHSAA Sportsmanship award at the Regional level.

Athletic Secretary Terri Sytsma was honored by the MIAAA for 15 years of service with Fruitport Community Schools Athletics.

Steve Wilson was honored as MHSFCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Boys Track Coach Chad Brandow was named the Lakes 8 Spring Coach of the Year.

Fruitport completed stage one of the MIAAA Exemplary Athletic Program recognition and has been selected for a site visit for the fall of 2008.
