Significant Accomplishments

There was an overall 3% increase in student athlete participation over the 2007-08 school year.

Jacob Batch was the GMAA championship in cross country, and finished 10th overall at the State championships.

The Boys track team won back to back Conference Championships, and the girls team won its third consecutive championship and its first ever GMAA championship.

The Boys soccer team repeated as Conference and District champions, returned to the regional championship and a top ten finish with a record of 20-4.

The volleyball team returned to the state championship game this year after a memorable upset of #1 North Branch in the semi-finals. The Trojans continued their winning ways in the Conference and GMAA championships.

The Girls track team set new records in the pole vault, long jump, and 3200 relay. Exchange student Mona Auervolle broke a long jump record held since 1975.

Taylor Blanchette and Jake Johnson qualified for the Boys Bowling State Finals.

Fruitport hosted championships in GMAA Competitive Cheer, MHSAA Regional Bowling, Lakes 8 Track and Field, District Baseball and Softball .

Girls track coach Randy Johnson was named Lakes 8 Spring Coach of the Year.

Ken Erny was named the Lakes 8 Fall Coach of the Year and will turn over duties after 19 years as the varsity Boys soccer coach at FHS.

Fruitport completed the MIAAA Exemplary Athletic Program site visit and was recognized as the 2009 award recipient at the MIAAA convention in March.

JV Girls Basketball coach Bill Stone completed all six components (36 hours) of the MHSAA's Coach's Advancement Program.

Head Football coach Steve Wilson was named President of the Football Coach's Association (MHSFCA).

Girls Soccer coach David Hulings continues as Executive Director for the State Soccer Coaches Association (MHSSCA).
