# SIGNIFICANT ACCOMPLISHMENTS

## AN EXTRA ORDINARY YEAR IN SPORTS/THE END OF AN ERA FOR LAKES 8 LEAGUE COMPETITION

*It may have been the extra practice last fall. Maybe the stolen base that led to the winning run in the come from behind win on the diamond...maybe the January win at Ludington that resulted in the first ever GBB league co-championship; or perhaps the training and words of encouragement received from a middle school coach four years earlier that made the difference...*

*..maybe it was the constant preparation for our most memorable track season, or the boys basketball team's big wins over MCC. Perhaps it was the preseason camp, the spring trip or overnight team building, the extra hours in the weight room over the last 12 months, the camaraderie of a team of coaches, the multiple 1% gains made in training, preparation, or conditioning, and in engaging each player on the team-whether a starter or a non-starter...*

*Certainly contributing was the bowling teams' high finishes and the record breaking performances of individuals in soccer, track, baseball, softball. It was boys XC, softball, and boys and girls basketball gaining 20 points each from last year's overall third place finish in the standings. *It was very likely linked to the fact that this year's senior class had 18 athletes (seven were three sport athletes) that earned six or more varsity letters in their career (the second highest since 2002)-providing the DEPTH needed in all our programs.**

*It was an overall improvement from last season of 120 points. Translation: our teams finished a full 12 positions higher than we did last year in the 17 varsity sports in the Lakes 8 All Sports Standings. Seven teams improved their place, and five teams won league championships. A record six Trojan coaches were chosen by their peers as coach of the year.*

*With that being said, congratulations to every student athlete, every head coach, assistant, subvarsity and middle school coach, every support person behind the scenes! **For the first time in the history of any league participation, the Trojans take home the League's All Sports Trophy!** (The one that has been in SL trophy case for the last 10 years).*

Six Fruitport coaches were honored by conference peers as coaches of the year.

**The Lakes 8 Conference** selected girls basketball coach **Bob German** as winter sports Coach of the Year. Other coaches earning Coach of the year honors by sport were:

## Fall Highlights

The **boys soccer** team won 11 consecutive games en route to an 18-3-1 overall record, and a school record 96 goals. **Noah Hendricks** broke school soccer records for goals in a season (38) and assists in a season (21).

The **football** team kept the Bayou Battle oar in the Rivalry game vs Spring Lake.  
The **boys cross country** team won their first GMAA championship in 22 years!

## Winter Highlights

The **girls basketball** team won a share of the Lakes 8 crown and marks the first ever league championship and best record (17-4). Junior **Iyana Brown** (Girls basketball) became Fruitport's first ever All State Girls Basketball player. She now holds the season average scoring record (**20.3** ppg). Senior **Alyssa Veihl** broke the season rebounding record (**219**).

**Mackenzie Plichta** was the GMAA girls bowling champion.

**Rachel Pierce** was the girls bowling champion for both the Lakes 8 and Div. 2 Regional.

The **boys basketball** team finished third with a 6-4 season conference record, one of their best in recent history.

## Spring Highlights

The **boys track** team won their *third* consecutive **GMAA track championship**, fourth straight Conference Championship, and earned the highest finish at the state level (9<sup>th</sup>).

*Seven* **boys track** records were broken this year. **Noah Hendricks** set the new school record of **1:55.94** in the 800 m run and **49.83** in the 400 m run. **Nick Kramer** broke his own record for the discus with a throw of **172'**. Relay team records that fell included

4 x 100 (**Chris Kramer, Cameron Brandow, Nick Kramer, Wyatt Kendra**) **44.21**;

4 x 200 (**Wyatt Kendra, Cameron Brandow, Noah Hendricks, Nick Kramer**) **130.05**;

4 x 400 (**Noah Hendricks, Nick Kramer, Cameron Brandow, Cameron Oleen**) **3:22.70**;

4 x 800 (**Kody Brooks, Cameron Oleen, Seth Glover, Noah Hendricks**) **7:54.39**.

The **girls tennis team** accomplishments as a team as well as in individual achievements were extraordinary.

#1 singles player **Alicia Winter** (best season record for #1 singles in school history) took championships in GMAA competition and was regional champion. #4 Singles **Trinity Busscher** was 30-1. The team qualified for state for the third time in 20 years, missing the regional championship by one point, and finishing 13<sup>th</sup> in division 3; the best finish in school history.

**Zac Miller** (baseball) owns the new school record with a 1.18 ERA.

**Alicia Winter** was named the area's best girls tennis player.

## Other

*Eighteen* athletes received the Athletic Foundation's **Outstanding Achievement Award** for receiving 6 or more Varsity letters in a four year career. This was the second highest number of achievement awards given to a senior class.

The **Fruitport Hall** of Fame inducted its fourth class in March. The banquet had nearly 250 attendees.

The **Fruitport Athletic Foundation** issued over \$15,000 in coach and athletic department grants for 16-17.
