SIGNIFICANT ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Multiple records fell this past school year in girls' basketball, track and field, girls' soccer, bowling, softball, and girls' tennis. Likely the **longest standing of all the records** was in the girls 800 M relay at the state finals, where the Trojans team beat the previous record set in 1979. Another record broken also won the state championship in the 400 M run. It is highly probable that there has *never been a single year in which so many record breaking achievements took place*. Fall Highlights

The first ever OK Championship for Fruitport comes in **Boys Cross Country**, with **Aaron Simot** finishing first. Trojan **Volleyball** was next, earning a co-championship with Mona Shores in a hotly contested four way race. A week later they won the Class B District Championship, before falling to Holland Christian in the Regionals.

Winter Highlights

The **girls' basketball** team earned BCAM's "Top 100" Sportsmanship award recognizing our athletes and staff.

Iyana Brown (girls basketball) earned All-Conference honors in a very talented league. She went on to break the career scoring record, and also holds the season average scoring record.

Rachel Pierce was the Division 2 Regional bowling champion.

The **wrestling team** finished the regular conference season with a 5-1 record, losing only to RP.

Spring Highlights

The **boys' track** team won their *fourth* consecutive **GMAA track championship**, *fifth* straight Conference Championship, and earned the highest finish at the state level (9th). The **girls' track team** had a record breaking year, including two relay teams that qualified for state, one breaking a 37 year school record.

The **girls' tennis team** accomplishments continued, as they again qualified for state finals-this time by winning their first Regional championship in 25 years.

Other

Eighteen athletes received the Athletic Foundation's **Outstanding Achievement Award** for receiving 6 or more Varsity letters in a four year career. This was the second highest number of achievement awards given to a senior class.

The **Fruitport Hall** of Fame inducted its fifth class in March. The banquet had nearly 275 attendees.

The **Fruitport Athletic Foundation** issued \$16,360 in coach and athletic department grants for 16-17.

578 roster spots marks our second highest **participation rates** since the season changes in 2008.
